A HEALTHFUL RECIPE

Baja Mango Black Bean Lettuce Wraps Serves:4

Ingredients

- 2 cups black beans, or canned no- saltadded or low-sodium black beans drained
- 1/2 large ripe avocado, peeled pitted & mashed
- 4 cloves roasted garlic, mashed
- 1/3 cup fresh tomatoes, chopped
- 1/2 medium green bell pepper, seeded and chopped
- 1 mango diced
- 2 red radishes, diced
- 1 jalapeño pepper, diced and seeded
- 3 green onions, chopped
- 1/3 cup chopped fresh cilantro
- 2 tablespoons fresh lime juice
- 1 teaspoon ground cumin
- 8 large romaine or Boston lettuce leaves

Method

In a bowl, mash together beans, avocado, 1. and garlic with a fork until well

blended and only slightly chunky.

2. Add all ingredients except the lettuce, and mix.

Place approximately 1/4 cup of the mix-3. ture in the centre of each lettuce leaf and roll up like a burrito.


