A HEALTHFUL RECIPE

Warm Corn and Zucchini Salad with Mint

Serves: 4

<u>Ingredients</u>

1/2 cup lowsodium or no salt added vegetable broth or more if needed to achieve desired consistency



- 1 cup diced Onion
- 2 teaspoons or 4 cloves minced Garlic
- 2 cups diced Zucchini/Courgette
- 2 cups fresh Corn kernels
- 1/4 teaspoon ground Cumin
- 1/4 teaspoon ground Coriander
- 3 tablespoons chopped fresh Mint
- 1 tablespoon fresh Lemon Juice
- Ground Cayenne /fresh minced mild Chilli pepper to taste

Method

- 1. Heat vegetable broth in a large saute pan.
- Add Onion, Garlic, Zucchini/Courgette and Corn and saute for 10 minutes or until vegetables are tender.
- 3. Add Cumin and coriander and continue cooking until liquid is evaporated.
- 4. Remove from heat.
- 5. Add Mint, Lemon juice and Pepper.


